We are keen to keep you updated about our on-going anti-bullying work at George Fentham Endowed School. As well as keeping this high profile throughout the curriculum and in our day-to-day work, next week all pupils will be taking part in daily activities and discussions about bullying. Our aim is to ensure that the children fully understand our definition of bullying, its impact and are familiar with a range of prevention strategies.

At George Fentham, we define bullying as: **Behaviour by an individual or group, usually repeated over time, that intentionally hurts another individual or group either physically or emotionally** (and that this is different to an occasional fallout with friends).

To help children understand this we will be introducing the **STOP** message
